Rambler Mining drills seven metres of high grade copper

Rambler Metals and Mining plc (TSXV: RAB, AIM: RMM) continued to produce extremely encouraging drill results from the Lower Footwall Zone at the Ming Copper-Gold Mine in Eastern Canada.

Additional drill results returned copper grades up to 3.74%, with average copper grades exceeding 2%. Rambler is currently drilling underground as part of a pre-feasibility study into redeveloping the mine with a 4000 tonnes per day operation. The Lower Footwall Zone is located only 100 metres and runs parallel to the original underground mine.

“Rambler is confident that the results of these drill programs will continue to build on the resource estimate outlined in the NI 43-101 Report released on June 16th 2008” added Larry Pilgrim, Chief Geologist of Rambler Metals and Mining.
